The Wayne County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, October 19, 2021 at 9:04 a.m. in the Commissioners Meeting Room in the Wayne County Courthouse Annex, Goldsboro, North Carolina, after due notice thereof had been given.

Members present: George Wayne Aycock, Jr., Chairman; Freeman Hardison, Jr., Vice-Chairman; Barbara Aycock; Joe Daughtery; Bevan Foster; Chris Gurley and Antonio Williams.

Members absent: None

Briefing Session

During the scheduled briefing and prior to the regularly scheduled meeting, the Board of Commissioners held an advertised briefing session to discuss the items of business on the agenda.

The briefing began at 8:00 a.m. with County Manager Craig Honeycutt reviewing the agenda. He added the following:

- Add Motion to Adjust Food Lion Lease to include an additional six (6) months at a reduced rate not to exceed \$30,000, pending County Attorneys' Approval and Appropriate Budget Amendment to #12 under Consent Agenda.
- Add General Statute 153A-104 to #11 of #2 under New Business.
- Add Appointment Committee.

Finance Director Allison Speight reviewed the Budget Amendments and answered questions from the board.

Staff Attorney Andrew Neal reviewed the surplus property upset bid for 807 S. Slocumb Street.

Tax Administrator Alan Lumpkin reviewed the resolution authorizing electronic listing of personal property in Wayne County.

Commissioner Bevan Foster reviewed his motion to amend the vaccination policy to include non-vaccinated employees. Human Resources Director Ginger Moore explained the legalities of the policy and donated time between employees in special circumstances.

Commissioner Joe Daughtery discussed his thoughts on the proposed changes to the Vaccination Policy, stating the original intent was to encourage employees to become vaccinated. Commissioner Chris Gurley asked several questions. Commissioner Bevan Foster asked several questions and stated he felt the current policy was a "prize" for those who received a shot. Commissioner Gurley expressed his concerns of pitting employees against one another. Vice-Chairman Freeman Hardison, Jr. stated he agreed with Commissioner Foster.

Commissioner Daughtery shared the State's concerns over Wayne County's vaccination numbers and Commissioner Foster disputed Commissioner Daughtery's statement.

Recess the Board of Commissioners Meeting

At 8:51 a.m., Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr. recessed the meeting of the Board of Commissioners.

Call to Order

Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr. called the meeting of the Wayne County Board of Commissioners to order.

Invocation

Commissioner Joe Daughtery gave the invocation.

Pledge of Allegiance

Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr. led the Board of Commissioners in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Approval of Minutes

Upon motion of Vice-Chairman Freeman Hardison, Jr., the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the minutes of the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Commissioners on October 5, 2021.

Upon motion of Commissioner Chris Gurley, the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved and authorized the adjusted agenda.

Commissioner Barbara Aycock thanked the First Responders for helping her through her personal tragedies and Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr. thanked the First Responders for all they do for Wayne County.

Update from Dr. H. Edward Croom, President of the University of Mount Olive (UMO)

University of Mount Olive President Dr. H. Edward Croom shared information on the economic impact of UMO on Wayne County. He stated approximately 1000 students live on the campus daily with approximately 2000 students attending total, and 24 countries are represented on the campus. Dr. Croom discussed the nursing program, one of just a few universities with a realistic mannequin for training that is capable of growing tumors, giving birth, and giving blood. He also shared the universities, such as UNC and NC State no longer requiring SATs for entrance, creating a more difficult task for universities competing for students.

Dr. Croom stated UMO works closely with Wayne Community College and shared details on their Cohort and Ag Programs.

Upon motion of Commissioner Joe Daughtery, the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the Amendment to the Wayne County Subdivision Ordinance.

Motion to Approve moving one Monthly Meeting of the Board of Commissioners to an Afternoon Meeting

Commissioner Bevan Foster requested the matter be placed on the agenda and stated the issue was originally brought up by Commissioner Antonio Williams. He said he researched other counties and most have one afternoon meeting. Commissioner Foster stated 70% of the workforce is working during current meeting hours. Commissioner Antonio Williams shared his thoughts. Commissioner Foster recommended moving one meeting to 4 p.m., beginning with a work session. Commissioner Joe Daughtery recommended having one meeting in the afternoon each quarter, but not monthly. Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr. stated afternoon meetings have not been successful with previous boards and he and Commissioner Foster discussed "successful" meetings.

Upon motion of Commissioner Bevan Foster, the Board of Commissioners did not approve moving one monthly meeting of the Board of Commissioners to an afternoon meeting. Voting in favor of the motion were Commissioner Bevan Foster and Commissioner Antonio Williams. Voting against the motion were Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr., Commissioner Freeman Hardison, Jr., Commissioner Barbara Aycock, Commissioner Joe Daughtery, and Commissioner Chris Gurley.

Upon motion of Commissioner Antonio Williams, the Board of Commissioners approved the Motion to Establish a Public Hearing on Tuesday, November 2, 2021, at 9:30 a.m. in the Commissioners Meeting Room in the Wayne County Courthouse Annex, 224 E. Walnut Street, Goldsboro, North Carolina, attached hereto as Attachment J, regarding the proposed Voter District Plan for the Wayne County Board of County Commissioners by a vote of 6 to 1. Voting against the motion was Commissioner Bevan Foster. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to gather public comment and input on the proposed Board of Commissioners Voter Districts prior to consideration by the Board of County Commissioners.

Motion to Amend the Vaccination Policy passed by the Board of Commissioners on September 21, 2021, to consider including non-vaccinated employees

Commissioner Antonio Williams made a motion to amend the original motion and add N.C.G.S. 153A-103.

Vice-Chairman Freeman Hardison, Jr. made a motion to amend Commissioner Williams' motion and rescind the Vaccination Policy.

Upon motion of Vice-Chairman Freeman Hardison, Jr., the motion to amend Commissioner Williams' motion to rescind the Vaccination Policy failed by vote of 4 to 3. Voting for the amendment were Commissioner Joe Daughtery, Commissioner Barbara Aycock, and Vice-Chairman Freeman Hardison, Jr. Voting against the amendment were Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr., Commissioner Bevan Foster, Commissioner Chris Gurley, and Commissioner Antonio Williams.

Commissioner Joe Daughtery made a motion to amend Commissioner Williams' motion to leave the Vaccination Policy as it stands, but add N.C.G.S. 153A-103 to item #11 of the policy, attached hereto as Attachment K. Voting for the amendment were Chairman

George Wayne Aycock, Jr., Commissioner Barbara Aycock, Commissioner Joe Daughtery, and Commissioner Antonio Williams. (Commissioner Williams raised his hand during the vote but after a request from Clerk to the Board Carol Bowden to roll call, Commissioner Williams stated he abstained, which stands as an affirmative vote.) Voting against the amendment were Vice-Chairman Freeman Hardison, Jr., Commissioner Bevan Foster, Commissioner Chris Gurley.

Clerk to the Board Carol Bowden asked for a roll call vote which led to lengthy discussion from the Board, including the laws on voting again on a motion that had passed.

Commissioner Williams stated there was confusion and made a motion to vote again. Commissioner Daughtery objected to the motion and said it was a bad precedent to set. County Attorney E. B. Borden Parker stated Commissioner Williams' motion as amended, was still before the Board.

Vice-Chairman Freeman Hardison, Jr. asked Staff Attorney Andrew Neal for clarification on what was being voted on and Mr. Neal stated it was an amended motion to include only vaccinated employees in the Vaccination Policy and add N.C.G.S. 153-103 to item #11. Voting for the amended motion were Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr.; Commissioner Barbara Aycock; Commissioner Joe Daughtery; and Commissioner Chris Gurley. Voting against the amended motion were Vice-Chairman Freeman Hardison, Jr.; Commissioner Bevan Foster; and Commissioner Antonio Williams.

Motion to Approve the Design-Bid-Build with General Contractor Pre-Qualification Process for the new addition to the Carey A. Winders Detention Center

Upon motion of Commissioner Chris Gurley, the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the Design-Bid-Build with General Contractor Pre-Qualification Process for the new addition to the Carey A. Winders Detention Center.

Motion to Approve TA Loving Company as the Construction Manager at Risk (CMAR) for the new combined DSS/Health Department Facility

County Manager Craig Honeycutt explained the CMAR process for the new combined DSS/Health Department Facility.

Upon motion of Commissioner Joe Daughtery, the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved TA Loving Company as the CMAR for the new combined DSS/Health Department Facility. Commissioner Bevan Foster abstained from voting, counting as an affirmative vote.

Commissioner Antonio Williams discussed the water and sewer issues in Mount Olive.

Commissioner Bevan Foster asked the other Board members to follow the policy set by the County and wear masks during the meetings.

Vice-Chairman Freeman Hardison, Jr. explained his vote on the Vaccination Policy and stated he agreed with Commissioner Williams' discussion on the Mount Olive issues.

Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr. thanked the First Responders who attended the meeting and those who were unable to due to working. He responded to Commissioner Foster regarding the mask mandate and stated he would try to do better at remembering his mask. He then stated if he was going to do that, Commissioners needed to adhere to the policy of cellphone usage being prohibited during Board of Commissioners meetings. Commissioner Foster challenged Chairman Aycock regarding an actual policy being in place and exited the meeting after calling him a dictator.

**RESOLUTION #2021-38: A RESOLUTION REDEFINING WAYNE COUNTY
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTORAL
DISTRICT BOUNDARIES**

WHEREAS, the Wayne County Board of Commissioners currently consists of seven members with six members elected by individual districts and one at large member;

WHEREAS, this board structure was approved by a three judge panel of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina, Raleigh Division in a case entitled Wayne County Branch of NAACP et al, Plaintiffs vs. Wayne County, North Carolina, et al, Defendants (5:1986-cv-1091); and

WHEREAS, the existing plan has been followed since the entry of the Consent Order in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina, Raleigh Division; and

WHEREAS, the Wayne County Board of Education utilizes the same electoral districts as the Board of Commissioners pursuant to the plan adopted by the Wayne County Board of Commissioners under NCGS § 115C-68.1 on September 17, 1991 entitled “Plan to Provide for the Merger and Consolidation of the Goldsboro City Board of Education and the Wayne County Board of Education and to Establish one Administrative Board of Education for all the Public Schools in Wayne County” which is recorded in Book 1318 at Page 279 of the Wayne County Registry; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Decennial Census data shows there is an inequality of population among all of the districts such that a failure to redistrict would cause existing districts to be in violation of current federal and state law; and

WHEREAS, North Carolina General Statute §153A-22 provides that when such inequality of population among electoral districts exists, the Board of Commissioners may, by Resolution, redefine the electoral districts; and

WHEREAS, Wayne County staff has produced a map containing an equitable population balance among the six districts entitled “2020 Commissioner District Map; Wayne County, North Carolina” which is attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, on November 2, 2021 the Wayne County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing to receive comments on the proposed electoral districts; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to North Carolina General Assembly Session Law 2021-56, any county which is divided into electoral districts for the purpose of nominating or election persons

to the board of commissioners must review and revise its electoral districts on or before November 17, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Wayne County Board of Commissioners that:

1. Based upon the 2020 Decennial Census there is an inequality of population in the existing Board of Commissioner Districts and redistricting is necessary pursuant to NCGS §153A-22 and applicable federal law.
2. 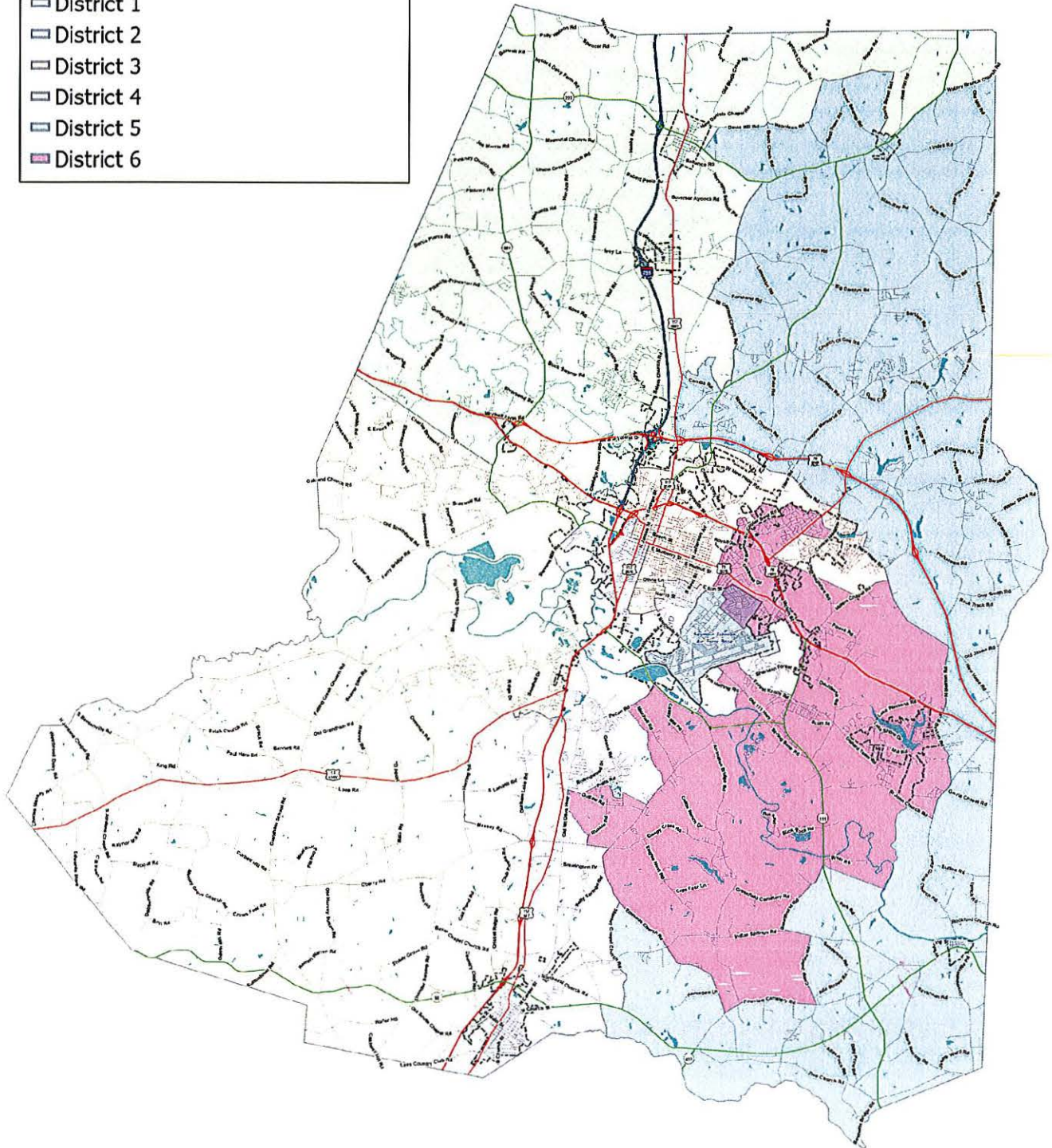

During the June 15, 2021 Board of Commissioners meeting, a discussion was held regarding whether the county would be moving forward with additional street assessment projects. Specifically, potential assessment projects for Eagle Ridge and Lane Tree subdivisions were discussed. During that meeting, the Assistant County Manager Chip Crumpler stated that NCDOT repair estimates had been requested for Eagle Ridge, and Mr. Crumpler was requested by Chairman Aycock to also request repair estimates for Lane Tree subdivision. It was agreed that the discussion of moving forward with these projects would resume once all estimates had been received.

At the July 20, 2021 Board of Commissioners meeting, County Manager Craig Honeycutt provided an update on the estimates received from NCDOT. He stated that the figures from NCDOT were unrealistic, and the county would be contracting with WithersRavenel to receive an accurate estimate.

A contract has since been presented to the county by WithersRavenel to prepare a cost estimate and repair recommendations for Lane Tree Village & Eagle Ridge subdivisions. The total cost for these services is \$22,000. This budget amendment appropriates fund balance for this contract. If the county moves forward with street assessment projects for these subdivisions, the cost of this contract will be included in the individual assessments. However, if the county does not move forward with these projects, the county will bear the full cost of securing these estimates.

When a tax foreclosure sells for more than the delinquent taxes and fees owed, the surplus funds are deposited with the clerk of court for the benefit of the property owner and any lienholders pursuant to NCGS §105-374(q) and NCGS §1-339.71.
