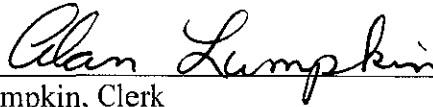

Members absent: None

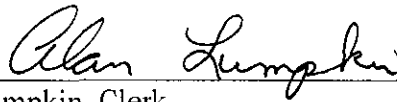
