The Wayne County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at 9:08 a.m. in the Commissioners Meeting Room in the Wayne County Courthouse Annex, Goldsboro, North Carolina, after due notice thereof had been given.

Members present: Joe C. Daughtery, Chairman; George Wayne Aycock, Jr., Vice-Chairman; Barbara Aycock; Bevan Foster; Chris Gurley (via Webex); Freeman Hardison, Jr.; and Antonio Williams.

Members absent: None

Briefing Session

During the scheduled briefing and prior to the regularly scheduled meeting, the Board of Commissioners held an advertised briefing session to discuss the items of business on the agenda.

The briefing began at 8:04 a.m. with County Manager Craig Honeycutt reviewing the agenda. The agenda was adjusted by the following:

Upon motion of Commissioner Freeman Hardison, Jr., the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved to adopt Resolution #2022-21 by a roll call vote.

Motion to Appoint Bill Pate as the Chairman of the ABC Board

Upon motion of Commissioner Freeman Hardison, Jr., the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the Appointment of Bill Pate as the Chairman of the Wayne County ABC Board by a roll call vote.

Discussion and Possible Approval of the Purchase of the Grantham Rescue Facility

Vice-Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr. and Commissioner Chris Gurley expressed their concerns about the purchase. Commissioner Barbara Aycock stated she had concerns as well and asked about renting the building. County Manager Craig Honeycutt stated the County currently rents the building. Commissioner Freeman Hardison, Jr. stated he was not in favor of spending \$400,000 on a new building on property that is wet.

Finance Director Allison Speight stated \$467,500 was budgeted for the project.

Facilities Director Kendall Lee estimated a cost of \$50,000 for a brand new roof, if needed.

Upon motion of Commissioner Freeman Hardison, Jr., the Board of Commissioners approved the motion to purchase the Grantham Rescue Facility, attached hereto as Attachment B, by a roll call vote of 4 to 3. Vice-Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr., Commissioner Barbara Aycock, and Commissioner Chris Gurley voted against the motion.

County Manager Craig Honeycutt presented information on the Resolution, attached hereto as Attachment F.

Upon motion of Commissioner Freeman Hardison, Jr., the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the Motion to Adopt Resolution #2022-23, by a roll call vote.

County Manager's Report

County Manager Craig Honeycutt thanked the Board and the Chamber of Commerce for their presentation. He said it was his final meeting but he would continue working through June 30th. Mr. Honeycutt spoke of the summer interns and thanked Commissioner Antonio Williams for his leadership in pushing for the program, as well as Human Resources Director Ginger Moore and her staff for working to implement the program. He introduced Charisma Barbour and Makayla Cobb, two interns for the County Manager's office, and Commissioner Antonio Williams recognized Alicia Pierce, the coordinator for the program. Ms. Pierce said there were 70 applicants from local high schools, with 60 interviewed, and 14 post-graduate applicants. 33 interns were hired by the County for the summer program.

Board of Commissioners Committee Reports

Chairman Joe C. Daugherty recognized County Manager Craig Honeycutt and stated he did professionally what others would not do; he stepped down as a county manager to become the Assistant County Manager of Wayne County, giving him one year under then-manager, George Wood. He read a list of accomplishments, hardships, and obstacles overcome during Mr. Honeycutt's five-and-a-half years in Wayne County. Following the comments, Chairman Joe C. Daugherty presented Mr. Honeycutt with a plaque.

Commissioner Chris Gurley stated he appreciated Mr. Honeycutt's leadership and apologized for not attending in person.

Commissioner Bevan Foster stated the Board of Commissioners Committee Reports was Committee Reports and Comments until August 2020, and he requested it be changed back.

Commissioner Barbara Aycock stated she attended the Broken Pieces meeting and encouraged all Commissioners to go to the next one.

Commissioner Antonio Williams attended County Assembly Day in Raleigh and discussed various bills passed by the legislature. He thanked Alicia Pierce and the County departments for supporting the summer youth employment program. He discussed the senseless shooting and challenged young people to think before reacting, telling them to stay cool, calm, and collected. He asked them to think about the families affected, especially the moms, before picking up a gun to settle a dispute.

Commissioner Freeman Hardison, Jr. had no comments.

Vice-Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr. thanked Raytrell Caldwell and Alicia Pierce for their work with the children who are our future. He also thanked County Manager Craig Honeycutt for his service to Wayne County.

Chairman Joe C. Daugherty reminded everyone of the July 5, 2022 meeting cancellation. He then continued his comments for Mr. Honeycutt, stating he is kind of laid back, and despite Chairman Daugherty telling him he needed to be tougher, he always found consensus and brought the parties together. He called it refreshing and said he did a great job for Wayne County. He announced his farewell reception at The Maxwell Center and stated, "Job well done!"

The Health Department (HD) currently has 2 vacancies for Environmental Health Specialist (EHS) as this position is difficult to recruit and retain. We have an interested licensed soil scientist who has been doing the same job for the state for the past 11+ years. Licensed soil scientists are tough to find and any new EHS employee would require at least 6 months of training to become proficient in the job. The county has seen incredible increase in demand for soil science services as we have received more than 1,100 requests for new construction permits as of June 30, 2022, (compared with about 400 such requests last year). While growth and development are good for Wayne County, right now our workforce cannot handle the demand.

Thus, we are requesting a salary of \$70,500 for this experienced new licensed soil scientist and a leave accrual rate of 13.3 hr/month (vs 8 hr/month) since he is currently at that rate with the state in the same position. The salary request is \$2,160 more than the next lowest comparable EHS employee with the HD who does not have the licensure.

Discussion: Sec 70-74 of the Wayne County Subdivision Ordinance requires that for every major subdivision within its territorial jurisdiction which does not qualify for the abbreviated minor subdivision procedure, the developer shall submit a preliminary plat which shall be reviewed and approved by the Board of Commissioners before any construction or installation of improvements may begin.

The Northwyck preliminary consists of 27 residential building lots. The plat shows one through street with a stubout and two cul de sac streets. Northwyck will be built on 15.78 acres on Antioch Road, just east of its intersection with NC Hwy 111 N. No mapped flood zones are present. The property is not located within a zoning area.

The average lot size is 21,300 sf or 0.49 acres. There are 1,952 linear feet (0.37 miles) of street required to be installed per the NC Dept. Of Transportation subdivision street requirements. Building lots will utilize public water and onsite sewer. The subdivision must meet the requirements for stormwater.

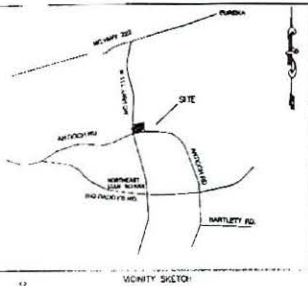

Re: Personnel Policy Update – 07/19/2022 Meeting

Attached to this memo are resolutions to amend Article XI, Section 3, and Article XI, Section 8 of the Wayne County Personnel Policy which addresses Retirement Benefits and 401(K) contributions.

Article XI, Section 3 currently outlines which pay types the county bases employee and employer retirement contributions. Local Government Employees Retirement Systems (LGERS) may change or update the contribution requirements. Therefore, the recommendation is to update the policy to reflect contributions will be based on gross salary as defined by LGERS and remove individual pay types from the policy.

Article XI, Section 8, currently allows employees to contribute up to 2%, or any flat-rate dollar amount, toward their voluntary 401(K) retirement accounts. In addition, the county will match up to 2% on 401(K), however, tracking the flat-rate contributions and ensuring employees are getting the proper match is becoming increasingly difficult. Therefore, the recommendation is to remove the option of flat-rate contributions.
