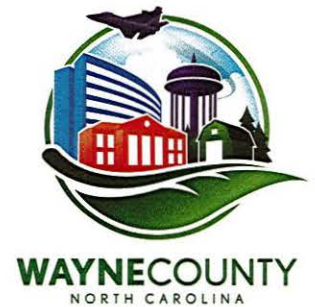

The Wayne County Board of Commissioners met on Tuesday, October 18, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners Meeting Room in the Wayne County Courthouse Annex, Goldsboro, North Carolina, after due notice thereof had been given.

Members present: Joe Daughtery, Chairman; George Wayne Aycock, Jr., Vice-Chairman; Barbara Aycock; Chris Gurley; Freeman Hardison, Jr.; and Antonio Williams (via Webex).

Briefing Session

Upon motion of Commissioner Freeman Hardison, Jr., the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved allowing Commissioner Antonio Williams to attend the meeting via Webex; however he would not be allowed to vote on any matter before the Board.

During the scheduled briefing and prior to the regularly scheduled meeting, the Board of Commissioners held an advertised briefing session to discuss the items of business on the agenda.

WHEREAS, Wayne County is home to Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, as well as veterans from across all branches of the military; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Wayne County have great respect, admiration, and the utmost gratitude for all of the men and women who have selflessly served our country and this community in the Armed Forces, and whose contributions and sacrifices have been vital in maintaining the freedoms and way of life enjoyed by our citizens; and

WHEREAS, Wayne County seeks to honor these men and women who have paid the high price for freedom by placing themselves in harm’s way for the good of all; and

WHEREAS, Veterans continue to serve our community by working side-by-side with us, serving in our churches and with our organizations, as well as in the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and by functioning as County Veteran Service Officers in 29 states to help fellow, former service members access more than \$52 million in federal health, disability, and compensation benefits each year; and

WHEREAS, studies indicate that up to 72% of service members experience high levels of stress during the transition from the military to civilian life, and many are at a high risk for suicide during their first year after military service; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties encourages all counties, parishes, and boroughs to recognize Operation Green Light for Veterans; and

WHEREAS, Wayne County believes all Veterans, especially those in our community, deserve special recognition for their sacrifices.

NOW, THEREFORE, with designation as a Green Light for Veterans County, the Wayne County Board of Commissioners hereby declares November 7th through November 13, 2022, as a time to salute and honor the service of our veterans, and encourages its citizens to recognize them and their immeasurable sacrifices by displaying a green light in a window of their businesses and homes during that week.
