The Wayne County Board of Commissioners met on Monday, December 2, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. in Hall 1-A of the Maxwell Center, 3114-A Wayne Memorial Drive, Goldsboro, North Carolina, after due notice thereof had been given.

Members present: Chairman Chris Gurley; Vice-Chairman George Wayne Aycock, Jr.; Barbara Aycock; Joe C. Daughtery; Bevan Foster; Tim Harrell; and Antonio Williams.

Upon motion of Commissioner George Wayne Aycock, Jr., the Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the nomination of Bevan Foster for Vice-Chairman of the Wayne County Board of Commissioners.

At 9:09 a.m., Chairwoman Barbara Aycock adjourned the meeting of the Wayne County Board of Commissioners.

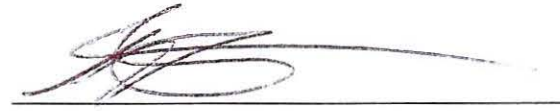
